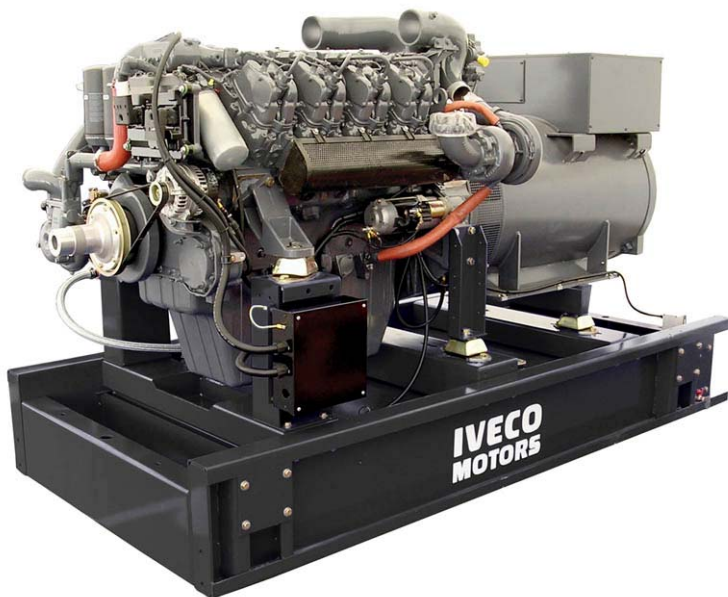


“IVECO MOTORS POWER GENERATION INCREASE THE POWER”.

Revolution in the range of power sets by IVECO MOTORS: the 2HENERGY factory at Fécamp (France) recently saw the final stages in the development of power generators based on the new VECTOR family 8 V-cylinder engine; this development was implemented in close collaboration with the Vector platform and the Arbon research centre.

Generating 720 kVA in Prime power, two GE Vector 8 units have already been commissioned for emergency services in the new Chambéry Hospital (France), with parallel passage network connections, thereby ensuring uninterrupted power supplies in the event of network black outs. A further 6 units gained French Army qualification for the supply of non-stop service power sets for use by F.I.R. (Prompt Response Unit) and will be operated in very heavy-duty conditions (outside temperatures of up to 60 °C). The installation will involve sound-proofed casings suitable for air freight handling and will be delivered by the end of September.



The new power generator, moreover, was acclaimed by some of the most important German manufacturers of power sets during a meeting called "VECTOR'S DAY" held at Fécamp in July.

The development programme will continue with Vector 8 gas, Vector 12 and Vector 16 versions.

This development will enable IVECO MOTORS POWER GENERATION to establish its position on the market for power outputs up to 1.5 MkVA, thereby filling the gap existing today.
